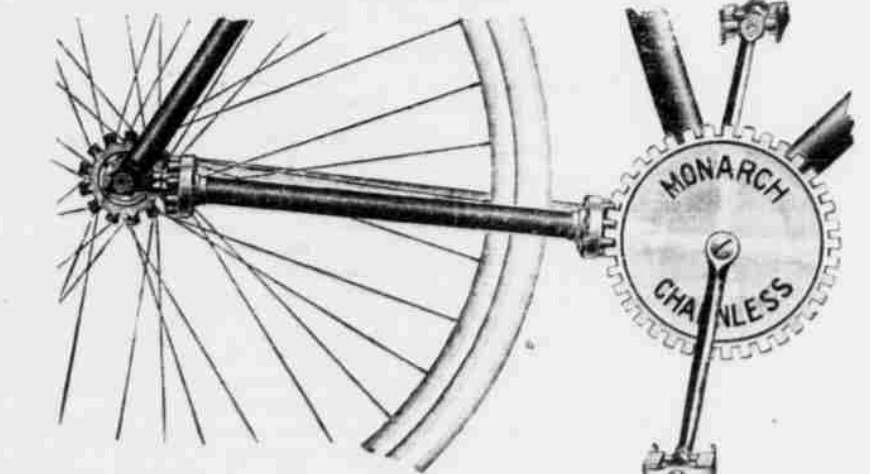

THE MONARCH CHAINLESS.
