

LETTER FROM MANILA.

MANILA, P. I., Sept. 11, 1898. EDITOR PLAINDEALER:—We are told that the steamer Newport is to leave here tomorrow at noon for San Francisco direct and is expected to make the trip in fifteen days.

We are still quartered in the Cuartel de Espana, the best barracks in the city of Manila. The walls of the buildings are of stone and brick, the floors of hard wood and the roofs corrugated iron.

The general health of Co. B is good. Geo. Starmer, who has been quite sick for some time, has been discharged for disability and will return home at once.

There are no others upon the sick report at the present time. Among those who have recently been upon sick report but are now returned to duty are: Sgt. F. S. Godfrey, Corp. Miller, and Privates Bussey, Riddle, Davis, Dixon.

Sgt. Pracht is called upon quite often to act as sergeant major. Sgt. Shambrook is color sergeant for second battalion. Company B had its picture taken a few days ago.

Dress parades are held in the evening about 6 o'clock, either in the quadrangle or out on the Lunette—a parade ground and park facing the bay.

We feel that our mission here is practically complete, unless perchance the government wishes to hold these islands. Whether it would be best or not I do not know, but they are undoubtedly very rich, and would be a source of great revenue.

Our boys are behaving themselves wonderfully well. Not one member of Co. B from Douglas county has been in the guard house. Sgt. Slocum, I think is the best man, physically, in the company.

Our men have all been furnished with white duck suits and present a very creditable appearance during these ceremonies. We will have a few things to tell you when we get home.

The following extracts are taken from F. S. Godfrey's last letter: It is very warm here 85 and 90 in the shade and nearly the same at night, but the atmosphere is very oppressive so that we feel the heat worse than when it is 100 at home.

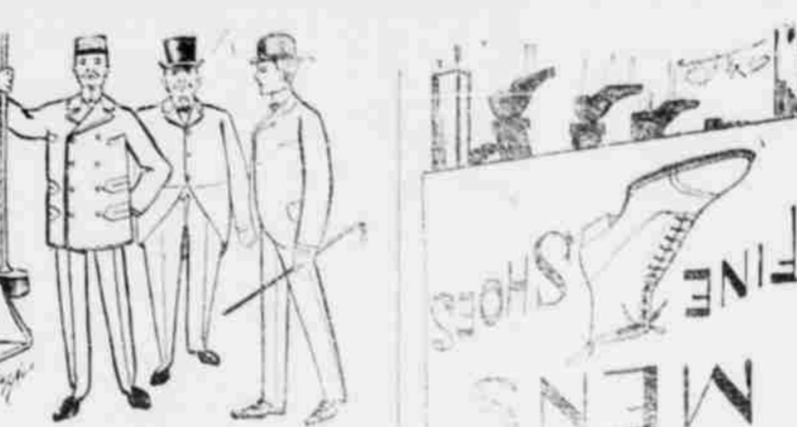

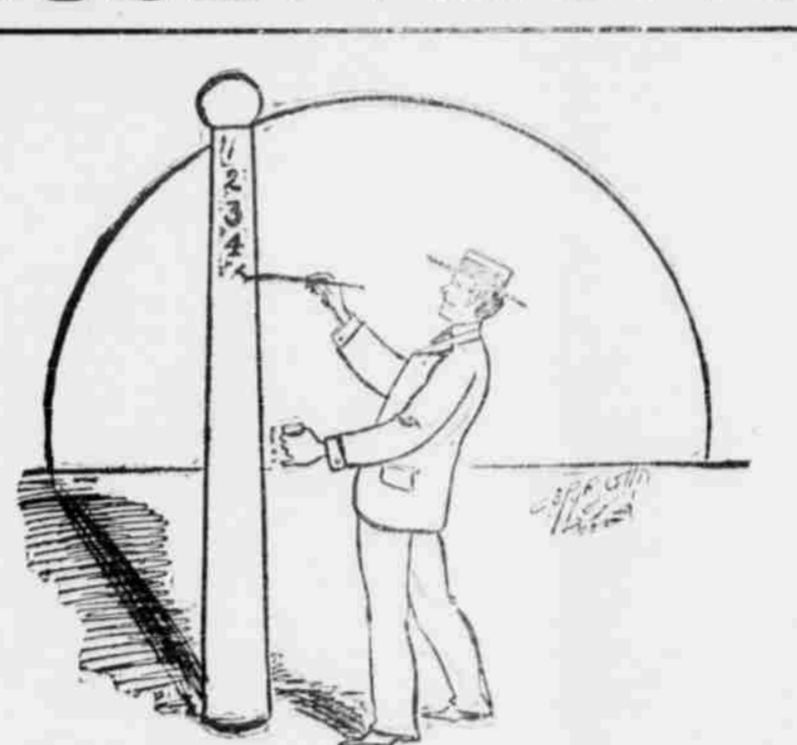
