Roosevelt's Ideal American. Colonel Roosevelt's picture of an ideal American is going the rounds. Finally his work must be disinterested and honest, and it must be given without regard to the effect it has upon his own fortunes; and while he must show the virtues of uprightness and tolerance and gentleness, he must also show the sterner virtues of courage, resolution and hardihood and the desire to war with merciless effectiveness against the existence of wrong.
