### APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR.

Paris Exposition Commissioners, Regents of the Ashland Normal School, and Dental Examiners.

SALEM, March 23.—This was a day for minor appointments at the executive office. A Paris exposition commission, two members of the state board of immigration, a board of regents of the Ashland state normal school and one member of the state board of dental examiners were named by Governor Geer.

The commissioners who will represent Oregon at the Paris exposition are: Henry L. Pittcock and Mrs. A. de Fontaine Smith, Portland; C. C. Beckman, Jacksonville; Mrs. Olive England, Salem; Alexander Gilbert, Astoria, and R. M. Mellis, Baker City. They will serve without pay. In connection with Mr. Mellis' appointment it is stated that several prominent mining men of Eastern Oregon wrote the governor, saying that if he was named a member of the commission to represent the mining interests of Oregon they would pay all his expenses.

The board of regents of the Ashland state normal school consists of nine members, all of whom were named today, as follows:

Jackson county, R. P. Neil, F. H. Carter and G. A. Gregory; Klamath, L. F. Willis and J. S. Orr; Lake, W. A. Macgill; Josephine, C. E. Harmon and H. C. Kinney; Coos, A. J. Sherwood. Carter and Gregory will serve six years each, Willis, Harmon and Macgill, four, and Orr, Sherwood and Neil, two.

Dr. G. S. Wright, of McMinnville, having been today appointed a member of the state board of dental examiners, to serve two years, from April 1, the board is now constituted as follows:

Dr. G. S. Wright, McMinnville; Dr. Thomas L. Nickum, Portland; Dr. W. W. Contrie, Salem; Dr. James M. Keene, Medford, and Dr. Norris B. Cox, Portland. The members of this board are to receive \$5 per day for actual service and expenses.

The state board of immigration is now constituted as follows: Charles K. Henry, Portland; Frank Davey, Salem; W. G. Goslin, Astoria; J. C. Cooper, McMinnville, and W. M. Colvig, Jacksonville. Henry and Davey were appointed today, Goslin and Cooper last December, and Colvig in February. They will serve without pay.
