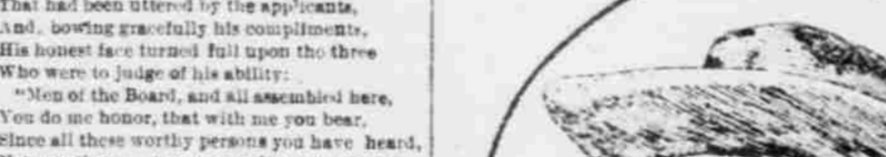
LONDON, Aug. 6.—All preparations have been completed for the return of King Edward to London tomorrow.
