THE NINETY-FIFTH ARCHBISHOP OF CANTERBURY.

He is Dr. Randall Thomas Davidson and is the first Successor of Augustine and Thomas a Becket to Visit America—His Career.

There are several reasons why more than ordinary interest attaches to the visit to America of the Archbishop of Canterbury, the Right Hon. and Most Rev. Dr. Randall Thomas Davidson.

Dr. Davidson is the ninety-fifth Archbishop of Canterbury, the see having been founded in 597 A. D. and he is the first occupant of this high ecclesiastical post to set foot on American soil.

Dr. Davidson's relations with Queen Victoria and led to his appointment as dean of Windsor and domestic chaplain to the queen. This was in 1858.

Before that year rich canopies had been offered him, but he had preferred to continue as private secretary to Archbishop Tait and, after his death, to Archbishop Benson.

From 1851 to 1855 he held the bishopric of Rochester, reputed to be the most laborious diocese in England, and in 1855 he was appointed bishop of Winchester, in which position he was serving when Archbishop Benson died.

He was a very popular and without it. He was a great admirer of the noted dissenting divine, C. H. Spurgeon, and pronounced the benediction at his grave.

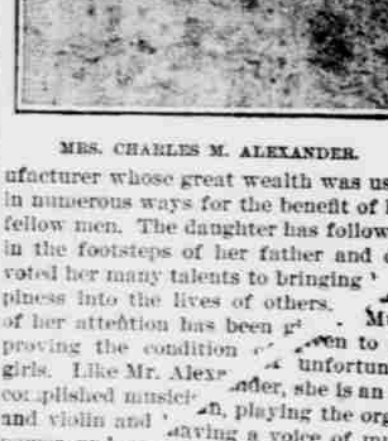
