CAN NOW FISH IN CRATER LAKE

Whereas, the Hon. Secretary of the Interior has in rule 7, Rules and Regulations of the Crater Lake National Park, delegated to the superintendent the authority to regulate fishing in any of the waters of the Park, and Whereas, Crater Lake, having in years past been stocked with trout, and it appearing that the said fish have become sufficiently numerous in the lake to justify such action, I now therefore, declare an open season for trout fishing in Crater Lake with hook and line only, the catch of any one person not to exceed five fish in any one day, from the fifteenth day of July to the fifteenth day of September, 1905, both inclusive, and for a like season of each succeeding year thereafter until otherwise ordered.

The date and provisions regulating the closed and open season for trout fishing, as fixed by the Statutes of Oregon shall apply in all other waters of Crater Lake National Park.

HOCH ESCAPES THE NOOSE

Chicago, July 28.—At the eleventh hour Johann Hoch, the convicted wife-murderer and confessed arch bigamist, received a ray of hope that he would not be executed for the murder of his wife, Marie Wecker Hoch. He was to hang between ten o'clock and noon today, but the march to the scaffold was delayed to the last moment pending the result of heroic efforts of friends to obtain the \$600 needed to complete the \$1000 necessary to make an appeal to the Supreme Court.

Dr. L. H. Montgomery, a well known physician, and Mrs. May Wilson, a woman of wealth, called at the jail at 10:30 and announced that they had raised the amount needed by Hoch. States Attorney Heady was informed and communicated with the governor. Montgomery has taken an interest in the case from a scientific view, asserting his opinion that the analysis was incorrect and that Hoch could not have committed the crime.

At 12:45 p. m. Governor Deneen reviewed Hoch until September 25th.

With scarcely more than an hour to spare before the time set for execution Johann Hoch, convicted wife murderer, was reviewed by Governor Deneen until Sept. 25th.

With the exception of a slight attack of nausea early this morning Hoch was in excellent spirits throughout the morning. When he learned the money had been raised to pay for an appeal, he called for another cigar, placed his feet on the table and said: "This proves my contention that I will not hang." The death waver says Hoch is the gamest man they ever stood guard over.

Sept. 1st the open season for killing of does opens, and closes with Oct. 31st.
Both must be killed between half hour before sunrise and one hour after sunset.
Each hunter must secure a license from the county clerk of the county.
