REAL STATUS OF CHINA'S EMPEROR.



This illustration shows well the humiliating treatment accorded to the Emperor of China by the Dowager Empress and makes it very plain who is the real ruler of the great empire. The fiction of pretending that the Emperor is in truth an emperor is maintained at the court receptions of the foreign ministers at Peking, but even on such occasions the unhappy ruler has to content himself with a seat behind a small table, while in the background and towering over him, the Dowager Empress is seated on the throne. The illustration was made from a sketch drawn by an officer who recently attended one of these levees.

A SECOND MAKAROFF.

Admiral Skrydloff Who Commands the Russian Vladivostock Fleet.

The raids of the Russian Vladivostock squadron under Admiral Skrydloff called for a good deal of unstinted praise. These raids have been most daring and to a considerable extent have interfered with the plans of the Japanese. This squadron sallted forth Oregon to prey upon Japanese transports and merchantmen, successfully eluding the Japanese fleet under Admiral Kalmura, sent in search of it. One particularly bold raid was out into the Pacific ocean, where it encountered and cap-

eral daring and successful attacks on Turkish ships, and baffled the efforts of the Turks to prevent the transport of the Russian troops over the Danube. He has held commands in the Pacific and knows the Far Eastern seas thoroughly. It is understood that but for the opposition of Admiral Alexieff, who does not favor Skrydloff, the latter would have been in command at Port Arthur in the first instance instead of Admiral Stark.
