The fiction of pretending that the Emperor is in truth an emperor is maintained at the court receptions of the foreign ministers at Peking, but even on such occasions the unhappy ruler has to content himself with a seat behind a small table, while in the background and towering over him, the Dowager Empress is seated on the throne. 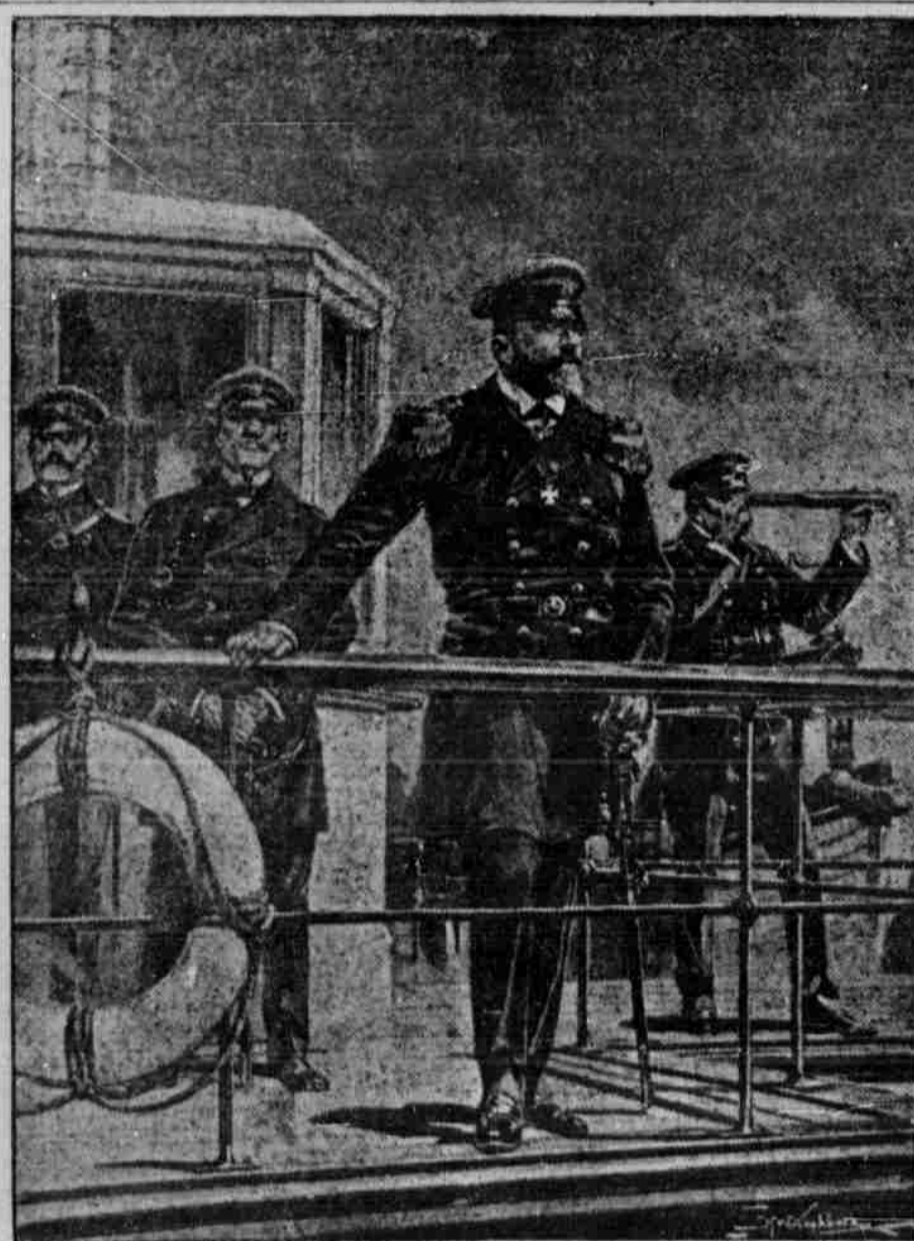
### A SECOND MAKAROFF.

Admiral Skrydloff Who Commands the Russian Vladivostock Fleet.

The raids of the Russian Vladivostock squadron under Admiral Skrydloff called for a good deal of unstinted praise. These raids have been most daring and to a considerable extent have interfered with the plans of the Japanese. This squadron sallied forth to prey upon Japanese transports and merchantmen, successfully eluding the Japanese fleet under Admiral Kaimura, sent in search of it. One particularly bold raid was out into the Pacific ocean, where it encountered and captured or sunk several vessels. The squadron was sufficiently powerful to

eral daring and successful attacks on Turkish ships, and baffled the efforts of the Turks to prevent the transport of the Russian troops over the Danube. He has held commands in the Pacific and knows the Far Eastern seas thoroughly. It is understood that but for the opposition of Admiral Alexieff, who does not favor Skrydloff, the latter would have been in command at Port Arthur in the first instance instead of Admiral Stark.

Furs Growing Scarce in Siberia. The wealth of Russia in furs is being rapidly sapped. It is reported that in a certain district of the Yenesei government, where fifty years ago hunters annually shot 28,000 sables, 6,000

cause a division of the Japanese fleet, thus weakening Admiral Togo's squadron before Port Arthur.

Admiral Skrydloff, commander of the squadron, is regarded as the ablest naval officer in the Russian service since the death of Makaroff, who perished with the battleship Petropavlovsk. On Makaroff's death Admiral Skrydloff was dispatched to the far east to take command at Port Arthur. Before he reached the east, however, Port Arthur was cut off both by sea and land by the Japanese. He consequently assumed the command at Vladivostock and his activity and daring raids perplexed the Japanese.

Vice Admiral Nikolai Iarionovitch Skrydloff, though not considered such a scientific seaman as the gallant officer who went down in the Petropavlovsk, is reputed to be full of dash and enterprise. He made his name in the Russo-Turkish war, when he led sev-
