Guilty Of Manslaughter.

The trial of W. H. Lucy, which was held at Canyon City, Oregon, on a charge of murder in the first degree for the killing of Ernest Hickman, which occurred in a saloon brawl, recently, was concluded at that place last week, and the case went to the jury. After being out seven hours the jury returned a verdict of manslaughter. The defense will file a motion for a new trial and if this is denied the case will be appealed to the supreme court.

It is not known from whom the Indian got the liquor, but from whoever it is he has but slight regard for the safety of his fellow men. It is less than a month since one drunken Indian murdered another and it is possible some white man may fall victim to some Indian crazed with fire water.
