John W. Robinson, a merchant from Ashwood, was in town on Friday last, taking his first look at the coming metropolis of Crook county. He was very much pleased with the appearance of Madras, and predicts a rapid and steady growth for a town surrounded by so productive a territory as adjoins Madras on all sides. It was rumored here that Mr. Robinson is contemplating the opening of a store at this place, although this rumor was not confirmed by him.

J. B. Cartwright, a prominent sheepman from Cross Keys, was in Madras yesterday. He says that prices for yearling sheep are 75 cents per head higher than they were last year at this time, while the prospects are that wool will sell for from 2 to 4 cents per pound higher prices than last year's price. Mr. Cartwright recently had an offer of \$10 per head for 1000 bred ewes, to be selected from the band by the purchaser, which offer he refused. This is undoubtedly the highest price ever offered in this state for range ewes.

Willis W. Brown has opened up a road along the automobile line, running through the north end of the Lyle & Brown ranch, by putting in gates, and hereafter the travel will be able to go that way and save about two and a half miles in the distance between this place and Cross Keys and points beyond. At the point where the road turned to the right to go through the Lyle & Brown home ranch by Heisler, there is now also a road which turns to the left, avoiding Heisler altogether. This will be a great convenience to the traveling public, who will be grateful to Mr. Brown for opening up the new road.

The new telephone line, which is to connect the Madras office with the long distance line at Haycreek, is being completed, and will be ready for service within a few days. The wire is being strung now. The new line connects with the long distance line within a distance of 12 miles, and will be used almost entirely for the long distance service, as there are very few local phones on it. The service will no doubt be very much better than that over the line which connects with Prineville, and the better service will be appreciated by the patrons of the office at this place. The new line is owned by Jack Sommers of Prineville.
