SEED WHEAT AT A PREMIUM

Uniatilla farmers are having a very hard time as a result of the recent cold weather. As the ground thaws out and it is possible to examine the seed, it is found that much of the fall-sown grain has been killed. T. G. Richardson of Cold Springs has a 1000 acre field which he will have to reseed. Other men are in as bad a predicament.

To add to the trouble seed wheat is very scarce, and it is feared that not enough can be found to supply the demand. One man paid \$1 a bushel for a load of best, and it is expected that this or higher prices will be asked before all orders are filled.
