**IT TAKES ELEVEN INNINGS**

**Madras Boys Throw Away Victory In The Eighth Inning.**

Prineville won the first game of the season with the Madras ball team, at this place last Sunday afternoon, after a hard fought battle which lasted eleven innings. The visitors had played a number of games this season and were in fairly good trim, and the most enthusiastic local fans did not anticipate that Madras would have even a look-in, but the result showed that the Madras boys are going to be in the reckoning at the tournament to be held at Prineville the first three days in July. Without any team practice, and with several of their best men out of the game, Madras had the game won all the way up until the eighth inning, when a wild throw to first by Larsen turned the scales and gave the visitors their winning runs. Up until that time, Madras was three runs ahead, when the wild throw to first let in three men and tied the score.
