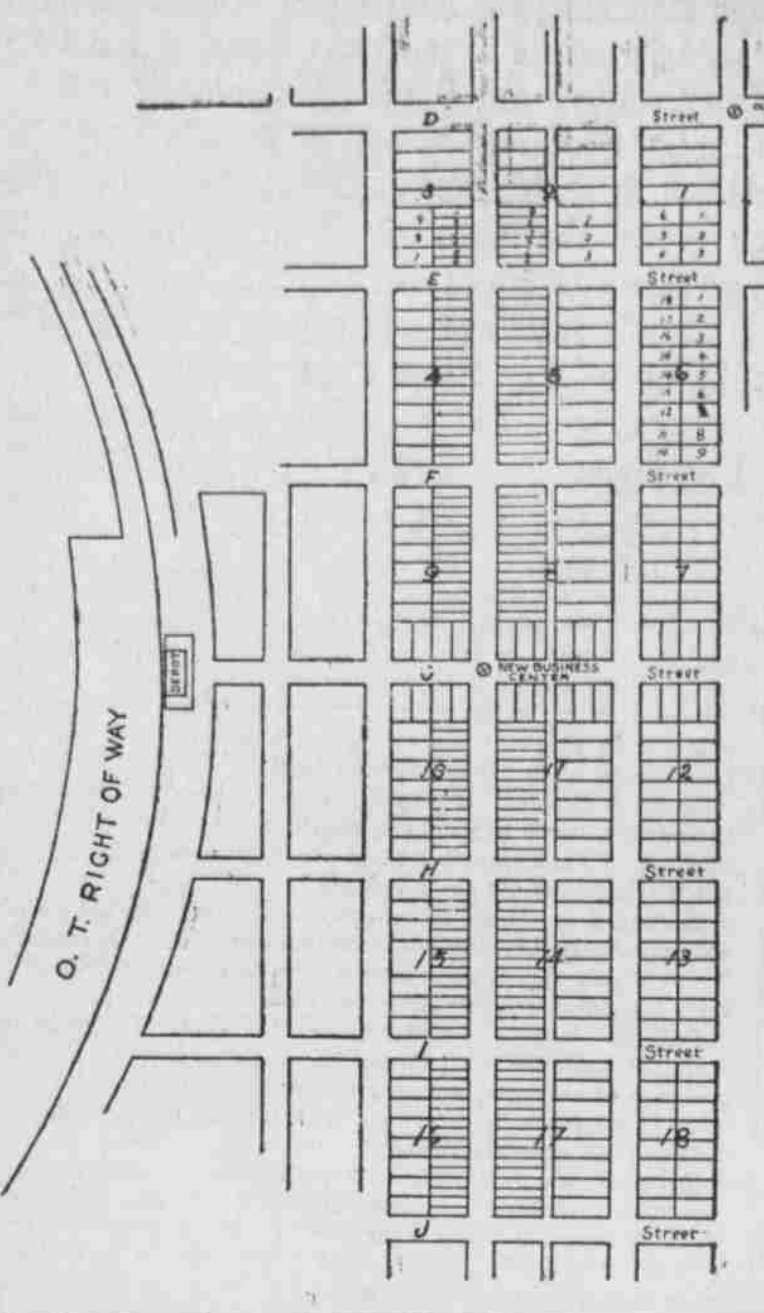


DEPOT ADDITION TO MADRAS, OREGON
