### Robert O'Donnell Dead

Robert O'Donnell, who has lived for years on his ranch on the Deschutes river, near what is now known as Coleman station on the Oregon Trunk railway, died very suddenly there last week. Mr. O'Donnell was about 50 years of age and was a bachelor. He was one of the pioneer residents of that part of the state and was well known by all of the old settlers. He was a native of New York state. Mrs. M. F. King, a sister resides in Portland, who with her son and daughter are the only near relatives in the west. The remains were shipped to Portland for interment.

### Gets New Commission

Postmaster Fred Davis has received from President Taft his new commission as postmaster at Madras for the next four years, dating March 22. This is Mr. Davis' second term, he having already served four years in that capacity.

## Sold Liquor to Indian Witness

Portland Bartenders Arrested and Put Under \$250 Bonds

Because they are alleged to have sold liquor to Custer Wallulatum, an Indian from the Warm Springs reservation, Frank Freeman and John Pinard, bartenders in Erickson's saloon in Portland, have been arrested by the United States marshal's office and put under \$250 bonds each by Judge Wolerton of the federal court. Custer Wallulatum, is one of the Indians to whom it is claimed liquor was sold by Madras people recently, and prosecution of the local cases is still pending.

"We are tired of having our Indian witnesses who are in attendance upon the Federal grand jury or upon the court during the trial of cases, drunk every time they are brought to Portland," said Deputy United States Attorney Maguire last night, "and we are prepared to arrest every saloonkeeper and bartender in Portland if it is necessary in order to put a stop to this thing. These two arrests that will be vigorously prosecuted, will serve as warning to all other saloonkeepers in town that we mean business. The next time we have a grand jury and have Indian witnesses here we shall have agents to keep watch upon them and to notify us of any infractions of the law. There are both state and Federal laws against selling liquor to these men thus to override both statutes will be summarily dealt with.

"The minimum penalty which the court is permitted to impose for each infraction of the law is a \$100 of fine and 60 days in jail. The judge may impose a fine as high as he sees fit, for the law places no limit upon it. The only limit to the punishment would be a fine or imprisonment which the higher courts would hold to be cruel or inhuman.

"Besides the Portland dispensers of whisky to Indians we have 14 others indicted who live in other parts of the state."
