Albert Esping

Albert Esping, who was fatally injured in a runaway near Shaniko and was brought to The Dalles hospital for treatment, died Wednesday, May 17. Mr. Esping was born in California, February 16, 1878 and came to The Dalles with his parents, Mr. and Mrs. F. T. Esping when quite small and was a resident here for about twenty years. He is survived by a wife and four children, a father and brother. Funeral services over the remains were held at the Methodist church at 3 o'clock Friday afternoon, conducted by Rev. J. D. Lewellen. Interment was made in the G. A. R. cemetery, beside the form of his mother, The Dalles Optimist.

Buys Forty Miles Wire

The Agency Plains Telephone company has purchased through the Central Oregon Mercantile company, forty miles of wire to be used in the construction of their new line from Madras to Mecca, and for the branch lines which are to serve the farms of the stockholders. The line is to be built as soon as the materials are available. A meeting of the board of directors was held Saturday night at Mountain View schoolhouse, when the standard for the class of phones to be installed was determined and other matters considered. The phones to be used will be of very high grade.
