from Fifth to Third street. Four-inch pipe along C street from Fifth street to Third street. One and one-half inch galvanized iron pipe along Third street from D street to C street. Four inch pipe from the eight-inch main on Fifth street toward the Oregon Trunk railway depot for a distance of 2000 feet. We will also furnish and install twelve hydrants in accordance with your plans, at points designated, make all of the necessary connections to the pumping plant and at such other points as are necessary and furnish the labor and material necessary for the construction of one pump house and one gate house in accordance with your plans. All of the above to be completed in a workmanlike manner.

We will bear the expense of having a competent engineer go over the entire plans and furnish a report on the same, and accept same when completed; we will do all of the above for the sum of \$10,000, taking in payment bonds bearing six per cent interest, issued by your town, at face value, provided the legality of such bonds is approved by our attorney, dated as soon as legally possible, due in 20 years, optional in ten years, with forty interest coupons attached, principal and semi-annual interest payable in New York City. Bonds to be in \$1000 denominations, and to be delivered to us in Portland or such other place as we may designate free of charge. You agree to promptly take such steps to make this issue legal as may be required and deemed necessary by our attorney and to promptly furnish us with certified copies of all the necessary legal proceedings had in the issuance of these bonds prior to the delivery to us. Bonds to be delivered to us from time to time, as the proceeds are actually needed in payment for work done.

Provided, however, that no payment shall be made in excess of \$1000 less than the cost or outlay expended upon said water works, and provided at least \$3000 in bonds be left with your city until said work has been fully completed and accepted as herein stated.

We agree to furnish a good and sufficient bond guaranteeing completion of said work and to save the city of Madras free

from any loss on account of any claim for damages or liens. Work to be commenced within ten days after our attorney passes and accepts the legality of such bonds and shall be completed within forty days thereafter. We agree that our attorney shall determine the legality of said bonds on or before July 1, 1911.
