Qualifications of Voter Any citizen of this State, male or female, who is twenty-one years of age and has resided in the district thirty days immediately proceding the meeting or election, and has property in the district, as shown by the last county assessment, and not assessed by the sheriff, on which sessed by the sheriff, on which
he or she is liable or subject to
pay a tax, shall be entitled ote at any school meeting or that, for the purposes of this section, any man who has de citizen of the United States, and has resided in the State for six months immediately preceedirg the meeting or election where he proposes to vote, shall be consid ered a citizen of this state; provided further, that any person shall be deemed to have com plied with the property qualifications imposed by this section who presents to the directors or judges of election satisfactory evidence that he or she has stock shares, or ownerseip in any co which has property in his distric as shown by the last county as sessment, and not assessed the sheriff, on which such co poration, firm, or co-partnersh er individual name does not appear upon the tax roll; provided
further, that in districts of the hird class any head of a family who is otherwise a qualified elec hor, and having children of school tor, and having children of schoo without property qualifications.
