The beeves after being slaughtered are taken to the cold room of the Central Oregon Ice & Cold Storage company from which depot the quarters are taken to the shop as needed. The shop is also equipped with refrigerators so that the meats are practically kept on ice from the time they are killed until delivered to the consumer.

Regarding the disappearance of Max Wilson, the Pioneer seems to have been in error in the article printed in the issue of June 8th, with reference to the dividing of the money by Mr. and Mrs. Wilson, at the Warmsprings Ferry, the afternoon of his disappearance.
