## TO HOLD EXAMINATION

Test Will Be Given at Madras on September 2

An examination for the position of rural letter carrier will be held at Madras on Saturday, September 2, by Postmaster Fred Davis, under the rules of the U. S. Civil Service Commission.

As a result of this examination it is expected that certification will be made for filling the position of carrier on rural route No. 2, from the Madras office, which will give Agency Plain an initiatory service of three times a week, and for other vacancies in the local office as they may occur decided in the interest of the service to fiil the vacancy by reinstatement, transfer or promo-

Applications for this examination must be made on the prescribed form, which, with necessary instructions and copies of the regulations, may be obtained from the Postmaster at the office

Applicants should their applications promptly. Unless applications are received by the Commission at Washington about ten days prior to the date of the examination it may be impracticable to admit the applicants to the pending examina-
