> Before the bonds in question can be finally issued, we shall require a certificate to the effect that there is no litigation pending or threatened which might affect the validity of the bonds. We are advised that there is certain litigation pending attacking the validity of the initiative and referendum amendment to the Oregon constitution. These cases are The State v. Standard Oil Company, in the Oregon Supreme Court, and The State v. Pacific States Telephone and Telegraph Company, in the U.S. Supreme Court. There may be other cases of which we have no knowledge: in any event, we shall require information as to the status of these cases before the bonds can be finally approved, because the questions involved in these cases affect the validity of the statute aforesaid which has been adopted under the constitutional provisions above referred to.
