LAND OFFICE RULES IN have not been binding upon the Federal Government, and in fact have been virtually overruled by contrary holdings of the Interior Department.

> From this record it is to be inferred that the Interior Department will not recogniz that a state's title to a school section attaches until the particular section is surveyed, and then only in the event there is no previous adverse claim. Where the state loses a section by this means however, the department holds it is entitled to make an indemnity selection, but cannot acquire the particular section on which a prior settlement was made.
