ORDINANCE NO. 46.

An Ordinance entit.ed an ordinance to adopt the Rules and Regulations and water rates prepared by the Water Commission of the City of Madras:

Be it ordained by the Common Sec. 1 Rules Regulations and Water Rates of the City of Madras. The following Rules and Regulations are hereby made and adopted by the "Water Commission of the City of Madras to secure an efficient and economical distribution of the water supply and to avoid any unnecessary waste of water and for these purposes it is hoped that the public will in their own interest co-operate with the commission.

Sec. 2 Applications for the use of water must be made to the President of the Water Commission, who, will furnish regulation blanks. Each application must be accompanied by the fee for tapping and installing meter, and no person will be permitted to tap mains or make any connection without permission of the water commission.

Sec. 3 When a permit has been obtained for service a corporation cock for the mains with lead pipe, tail piece and connections will be furnished by

Sec. 4. Any plumber making connections for a water appliwho issued it within twenty four hours after work is done

Sec. 5 Where water is supplied through one service pipe to several families or persons additional meters may be furnished

Sec. 6. Penalty for violating any of the Rules and Regulations of the Water Commission; Any person or persons or cor poration violating any of the provisions of the Rules and Regulations of the Water Commission, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof, before the Recorders Conuncil of the City of Madras: Court of the City of Madras, shall be fined not less than \$5.00 nor more than \$50.00 or be imprisioned in the City jail one day for each \$ 2.00 of such fine, or both fine and imprisionment, as may be adjudged against him or them.
