EXPERIMENT FARM GOES TO METOLIUS

Ground Just North of Town
Chosen by College Experts

A piece of ground just north of Metolius, and lying between two railroads, has been chosen by the committee from Oregon Agricultural College to locate the dry-farm demonstration farm for the year. Funds have recently been secured. This information was given in a letter from President Kerr, of the University. Reasons for the choice, President Kerr cites the facts that the Metolius tract is in splendid condition, ready for immediate use, provided with team and equipment, has a man living on the farm who is able to take charge of the work, is connected to the railroads, and was selected the best available for the purpose.

partly in crop, equipped ready for work, with the farmer already on the ground and willing to lease the whole for the year at reasonable price. Since there were funds for but one year, there was not time for clearing new land, and it was so necessary that the work should be readily inspected by the largest number of people possible, that land otherwise superior in soil, climate, or elevation conditions could not be used.

It is planned to do co-operative work near Bend, at Deschutes, in the vicinity of LaPine and near Hampton Buttes. The work begins at once. Plans for laying out and cropping the two farms, varieties and methods to be used and demonstrations to be made are already prepared by Prof. Scudder. Though the time is short, it is hoped to do much toward solving Crook County problems.

"WINTER TO WINTER" EXPOSITION SLOGAN

San Francisco Display to Open Gates
on February 20th, And Close on
December 4th

San Francisco, April 11, 1912
"Winter to Winter" is the slogan of the Panama-Pacific International Exposition, which is to open on Saturday February 20th, 1915, and close on Saturday, December 4th, 1915.

Missouri is the ninth state to select a site for its state building on the Exposition grounds. Thus far Oregon, Nevada, Montana, Washington, Idaho, Utah, South Dakota, the Philippine Islands and Missouri have received deeds to their land and promise the widest participation at the 1915 Exposition.

Alaska will also have a unique exhibit at the San Francisco exposition. It will consist of a copper ball weighing 2500 pounds, made of metal secured from the Copper River Valley, Alaska.

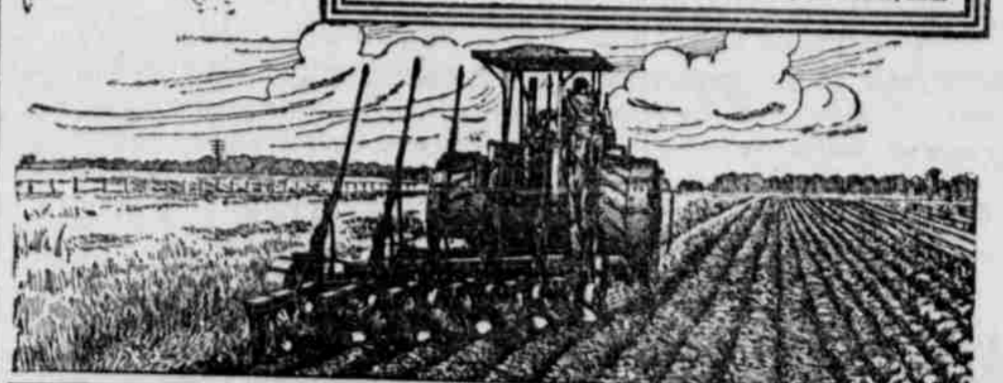
