### 101 RANCH TO SHOW AT REDMOND JUNE 13

Great Western Exhibition of Real  
Cowboys and Indians to Give Two  
Performances

The 101 Ranch Wild West Show is coming to Redmond June 13 and it will give the people of this vicinity an opportunity of seeing one of the grandest western exhibitions ever conceived. From the standpoint of both magnitude and merit this western aggregation is in a class by itself. Three long trains of double length cars are required to convey it through the country, and nearly 1000 men, women and horses participate in the performances. In every city where this stupendous show has been seen this year, the press has been generous in proclaiming it to be the most wonderful exhibition of modern times. The show comes direct from the great 101 Ranch at Bliss, Oklahoma, which is the largest ranch in the world and from it the show derives its name. On the morning of the day of the exhibition, a grand free street parade will be given, including Indians of every tribe not yet extinct. This parade should be seen by all whether the performances are attended, or not. Two performances will be given in Redmond. Patrons may feel safe with this show, as no gambling or catch-penny devices are tolerated either on the grounds or around them. The show carries its own force of detectives, and knowing that the dishonestly inclined will find it a wide berth.

### Expert at Metolius

Twice Each Week  
Until further notice, W. L. Powers, superintendent of the demonstration farms, will be at the dry land farm near Metolius on Tuesdays and Thursdays between trains, and may be seen at the office room in the rear of the Metolius State Bank on these days. A selected library of dry farming literature will be provided at this office and a supply of bulletins will be on hand for free distribution to dry farmers. The head office for the demonstration farms is located at Redmond, over the Bank of Commerce, and the office hours for the present will be Monday, Wednesday and Friday afternoons from 1 to 5 and all evenings of the week when Mr. Powers is in town from 7:30 to 9. This office will be provided with a selected library of literature on irrigation and general farming. A laboratory is being equipped in connection with this office for examination and a quick, approximate analysis of soils, water, alkali and seeds, and apparatus is on hand for soil surveying, leveling and measurement of water.

Beginning next week a series of talks to farmers will be issued by Mr. Powers through the press of this district. These talks will deal with subjects of timely, practical interest rather than follow any systematic order. The subjects will be chosen from the questions most frequently asked in the correspondence and interviews with farmers.

**Persian Lamb Skins.**  
The trade in Persian lamb or astrakhan skins centers in Turkestan, and the traders of that country have the entire monopoly of it. They pasture the ewe lambs in immense flocks, and it has been found useless to try to acclimatize these animals to any considerable change of climate. If they survive elsewhere the skin undergoes degeneration, and the fur consequently becomes less valuable.

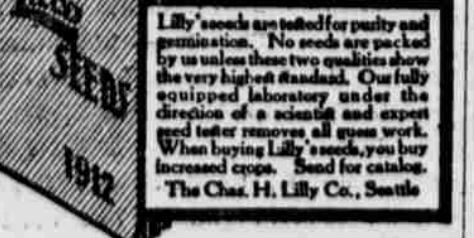
