From careful conducted experiments by different persons, it has been ascertained that one bushel of corn will make a little over ten and one-half pound of pork, gross; taking the result as a basis, the following deductions are made, which all our farmers would do well to lay by for a convenient reference, that-

When corn sells for 121 cents per bushel, pork costs 11 cents per pound.

pork costs 3 cents per pound. When corn costs 25 cents per bushel

pork costs 3 cents per pound. When corn costs 33 cents per bushel,

pork costs 4 cente per pound When corn costs 50 cents per bushel, pork costs 5 cents a pound.

The following statement shows what the farmer realized in his corn when sold in the form of pork.

When pork sells for 3 cents per pound at bring 25 cents per bushel in corn.

When pork sells for 4 cents per pound it brings 22 cents cents per bushel in

When pork sells for 5 cents per pound, it brings 45 cents per bushel in corn.
