It proposes to form a party that will, by political action, abolish all laws for the observance of Sunday, abolish all use of the Bible in public schools, either ostensibly as a text-book, or avowedly as a book of religious worship abolish the of religious worship, abolish the paying of public money to chaplains in Congress, or State Legis-latures, or in the army and navy, or in prisons or other public in-stitutions; abolish all appropri-ations to sectarian, educational, or ations to sectarian, educational, or other institutions, and demands that 'ecclesiastical property shall not be exempt from just taxation.'


