When apples were worth from four to seven dollars a bushel the orchards were as well taken care of as any lady's flower garden; but to look at them now one would think that they were of no value whatever, but rather a nuisance. Stock is allowed to run loose in them the whole year round; the Register of State Lands ... E. S. McComas ground is never plowed, or the is scarcely room for apples to grow. Congressman Jos. G. Wilson If fruit would grow in such plow the ground or mulch at least once every two years, thin out the top so that the sunshine can penetrate to every part of the tree, and then you will have fruit worth eating.






