It is not a dip, but a wash, and to put it on, in old tea-pot or a spouted tin should be used. The way to make it most effectual is to open the wool by making three marks on each side of the sheep...

Do the work well. Rub the liquid well into the skin. Be in no hurry about it as if you wanted to get over it as quickly as possible.

Examine the sheep every two or three days for three weeks, by which time the disease may be expected to be eradicated. If there are any white spots, rub on some of the following ointment...
