

AGRICULTURAL.

IMPROVE YOUR FARMS.—Make up your mind to steadily improve the condition of your land; above all kill the weeds; underdrain; grow more clover, peas and roots, and consume them all on the farm. Make more and better manure. Buy bran to feed out. Sell timothy hay, if need be, but never sell clover hay. Study the chemistry of manures. There are many places where artificial manures can be used to great advantage. Improve your stock; feed liberally. Raise a few thoroughbreds and gradually work your way into the business; but do not be in a hurry. Set out choice fruit trees, and take care of them. Spend moderately. Live within your income. Do not discount your prospects. And again I say kill weeds. Cultivate the land thoroughly. Make the weed-seeds grow, and then kill the young plants. I feel sure that the young farmer who follows this advice will not have to wait many years before getting his reward. I look upon it as absolutely certain that we shall get good prices for farm produce in the near future. I fear we shall get extravagantly high prices. I fear still more that few farmers will profit by them. Prices never have been and never can be high enough to make poor farming profitable. You must get your land in good condition now, and thus be able to avail yourselves of the high prices when they come—as come they will.—American Agriculturalist.

An Ohio correspondent of the Country Gentleman says: "I am using a remedy for driving away insects and bugs that works to a charm, and if any of your readers have not tried it, I advise them to waste no time with soot, ashes etc., but ask their druggist to order for them a pound of carbolic acid, No. 5, which will cost about 75 cents. If air slaked lime is to be had, use a teaspoonful of acid to a quart of lime; mix well, and dust over the plants. One application is frequently sufficient. The cabbage flea threatened to destroy my plants of cabbage and rutabagas, but one dose was sufficient to clear the garden of them. If the lime is not slaked, take one teaspoonful of acid to a pint of hot water, and slake the lime with the mixture.

Fowls can be fattened well in a fortnight if they are cooped up where they can obtain gravel and lime and are fed on scalded corn-meal, given three times a day while ears of corn are always at hand. For drink, skimmed milk is very desirable, and if warmed a little will be drunk with eagerness. Pulverized charcoal, kept either in their boxes or mixed with their food, will materially assist the fattening process.

The Wallingford Community.

A singular sect has secured a footing at Wallingford, Connecticut, known as the "Wallingford Community." It consists of about eighty individuals, one-half of whom are women. Their religion directs them not to marry, but each one selects a partner and the two live together four weeks, when a general change of partners is made, in order that there shall be no special affection for all are "brothers and sisters." When children are born, the mother is allowed to retain the child but a few weeks, when it is placed in the common nursery and all the "mothers" of the establishment take turns in caring for these "children of the community." This strange people came from Northern New Hampshire about twelve years ago, where the citizens were unable to dislodge them under the laws of prostitution, and the legislature passed a special act which obliged them to marry or leave. A few of them came quietly to Connecticut, purchased it without stating what they desired it for and the "family" possession. The Wallingford people prosecuted the concern as a house of ill-fame, but could not convict them under the existing laws. From that time the community have not been disturbed and has grown rich. The females dress in bloomer costume, and are seldom seen outside of their homes.
