### HEIR IS BORN IS BORN TO THRONE

Spain Celebrates Happy Event and Holidays Throughout Country Are Ordered.

Madrid, May 10.—Direct male succession to the throne of Spain was assured by the birth yesterday of a son to Queen Victoria. The news spread through the country and tonight the happy event is being celebrated from Gibraltar to the Pyrenees. Queen Victoria and son are doing well. The baptism will be Tuesday noon. In court circles it is desired to name it Carlos, but it has not yet been definitely decided.

A decree was issued tonight ordering a national holiday throughout Spain, Saturday, Sunday and Monday. The cabinet later presented to King Alfonso for his signature a decree transferring the title of the heir presumptive from Prince Charles of Bourbon to the new born prince. The king decreed pardons to thousands of prisoners, including eight who were condemned to death.
