**CZARINA BRINGS CARS**

Steam Freighter Also Carries Shipment of San Francisco Mill Machinery for Smith Mill.

The steamer *Czarina* arrived yesterday from San Francisco with a shipment of seven flat cars for the Coos Bay-Roseburg and Eastern Railroad. This is the second shipment received by the railroad in the past few days, making a total of 21 cars received. In addition to the cars the *Czarina* carried a large shipment of heavy saw mill machinery for the C. A. Smith Lumber and Manufacturing Company.

The *Czarina* is not rigged for handling heavy machinery, and as a result of these shipments new heavy gear had to be arranged. Captain Dugan states he will probably leave here Wednesday, after taking about 350 tons of fuel coal for the trip to Tacoma and back to Port Los Angeles.

The *Czarina* will take a cargo of ties from Tacoma.

**PLANT COMES IN**

The steamer *M. F. Plant* arrived in this port yesterday from San Francisco with one of the largest cargoes she has brought here for several months.
