Secretary Cortelyou has recommended appropriations for various harbors along the coast, including \$1,700,000 for completion of jetty at the mouth of the Columbia, \$200,000 for Gray's Harbor, \$130,000 for Port Orford Reef Life vessel, \$1,000,000 for brigade post to be selected on the Pacific coast. 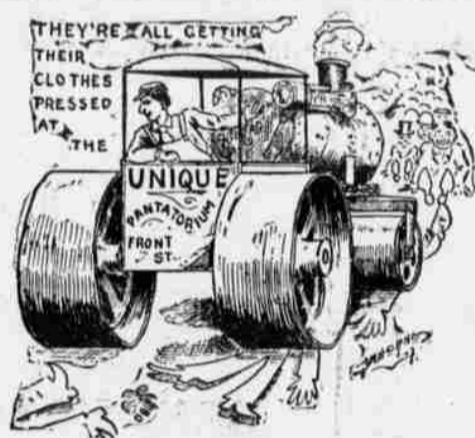
