WILL BOOM NORTHWEST.

The meeting of the Union Pacific stockholders at Salt Lake City, Tuesday, when the directors were authorized to issue \$100,000,000 of bonds for the further extension and development of the system, was an event of far-reaching importance to the country at large and especially to the Northwest. It will tend to restore public confidence everywhere to have it known that the Harriman interests purpose to go to work again building new lines and making improvements upon old trackage, says the Eugene Daily Guard.

For the Northwest it means the completion of many projects including the Drain-Coos Bay branch and Natron extension from Eugene to Klamath Falls. Thousands of men will be put to work again and it is more than likely that the sawmills of this section will soon receive orders from the railroad that will enable them to resume on full time. The railroads are said to use practically one-third of the cut of the mills, and it was the complete shut-down of railroad work, following the financial flurry, that was more responsible for the slump in the lumber market than any other one cause.

Taking all these matters into consideration, the meeting at Salt Lake City spells prosperity to the Northwest, through the development that will come from the building of new railroads and the effect that it is likely to have upon the lumbering industry.
