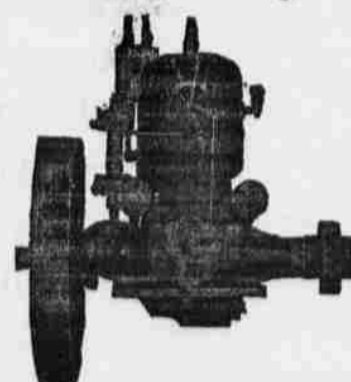

If you have been a resident of the State of Oregon for the Six Months next Proceeding June 1st, 1908, you can vote in the Precinct in which you reside, providing that you are an American Citizen or have declared intention of becoming such at least one year prior to Election Day. There are no requirements respecting length of residence in County and Precinct. If you have the above qualifications, claim your vote and no one can interfere with you.
