EXPECT WARM PHONE DEBATE

Independent and Pacific States Companies to Appear Before Council Tonight.

An animated discussion of the telephone situation on Coos Bay is expected before the city council tonight when R. T. Durett and his attorney, W. U. Douglas, will appear again and ask action on the franchise for the new independent exchange. John W. Gilkyson, division superintendent of the Pacific States company, arrived here yesterday to reinforce Manager L. R. Robertson in his opposition to the new company. Mr. Gilkyson has been conferring with a number of local business men since his arrival but refuses to make any statements prior to the council meeting this evening.

At the last session, the council laid Mr. Durett's proposed franchise on the table another week to give the Pacific States Telephone Company an opportunity to pledge some kind of improvement in their local exchange. Messrs. Durett and Douglas were nonplussed at this action as they had practically permitted the council and the city attorney to draft the franchise under which the new automatic telephone system was to operate.

It is understood that a number of

citizens will reinforce Messrs. Durett and Douglas' requests for a franchise at tonight's meeting.

In addition to the telephone matter, a number of street improvement projects will come up. The improvement of Prospect avenue will probably be ordered along the lines agreed to at the conference of Mayor Straw, City Engineer Sandberg and the Prospect avenue property owners.

Mr. and Mrs. T. Carey of North Bend, were visiting Mrs. and Mrs. M. Sherrard of Bay City, Sunday.

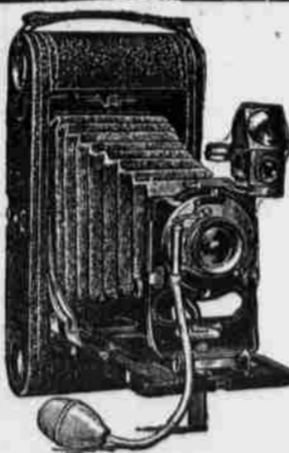

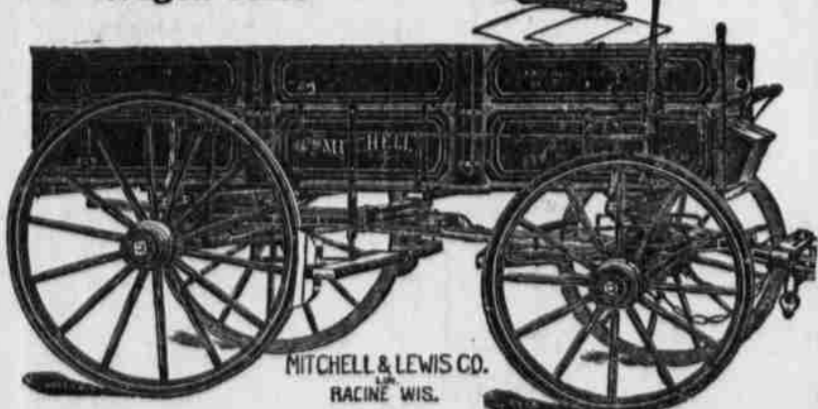
