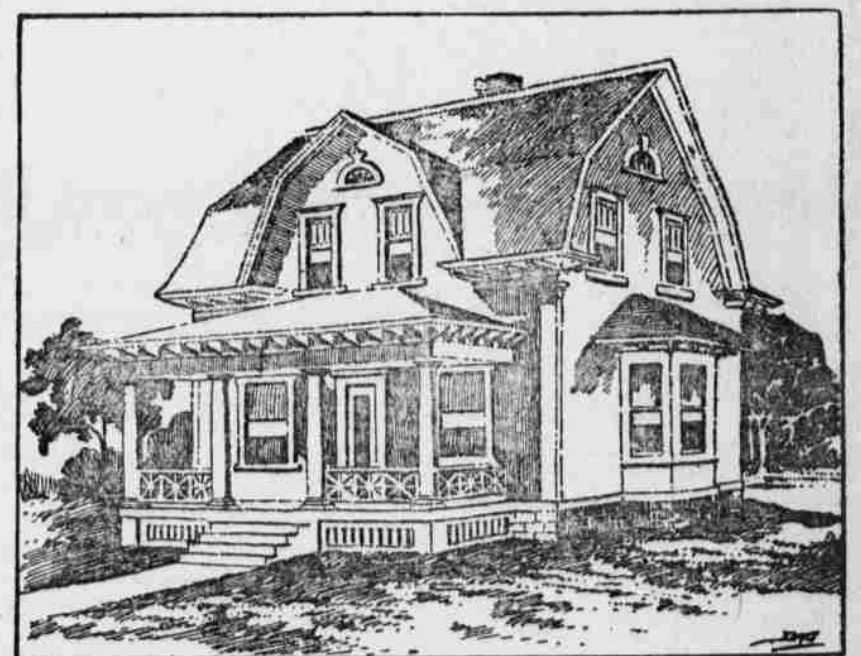
GENERAL WILLIAM BOOTH AT SEVENTY-NINE.

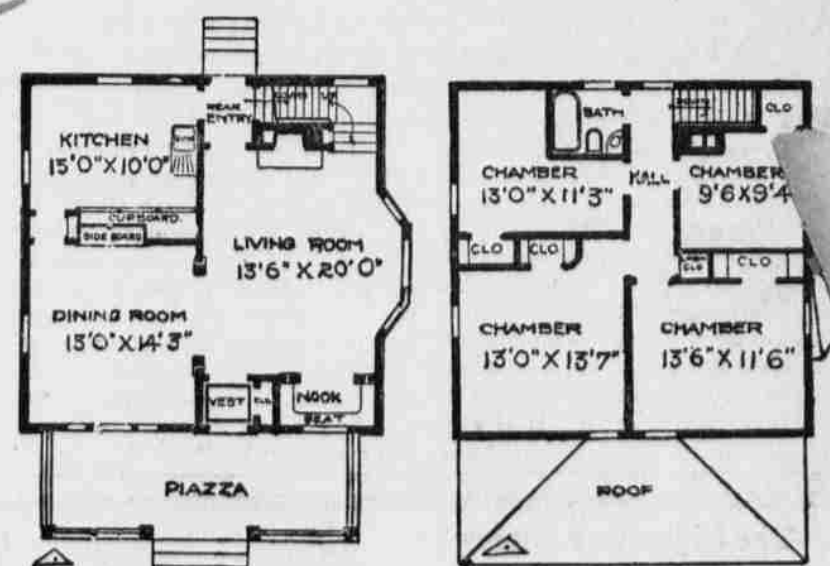
