**MAP SHOWS NEW RAILWAY**

**O. R. and N. Company Indicates Coos Bay Line Under Construction.**

The Oregon Railroad and Navigation Company has just issued a large wall map of the Pacific Northwest in which the Drain-Coos Bay line is shown as under construction. The map was issued under the supervision of Wm. McMurray of Portland, general passenger agent of the Oregon Railroad and Navigation Company, the title of E. H. Harriman's holding company in this section. A large number of the new maps have been issued, the first of which reached Marshfield yesterday.

The new map shows the Drain-Coos Bay line route as via Elkton, Scottsburg, slightly south of Gardiner and thence south along the west side of North Lake and Ten Mile, and apparently crossing the Bay to North Bend and thence to Marshfield connecting with the present line running to Myrtle Point.

The map does not show the Bandon southern line which many declare will be built just as soon as the line comes in here. The Bandon line, according to railroad prognosticators, will follow the old stage line down along the coast to Eureka and San Francisco.
