### NORTH BEND MILK WINS

"Sunrise" Carries Off High Honors in Condensary Exhibit At Oregon Fair.

Manager J. H. Keating of the North Bend Milk Condensary, Manufacturers of "Sunrise" carried off first honors in the Oregon State Fair. In addition to this a government inspector who inspected all of the exhibits said that the milk would have carried off honors in competition with any condensed milk in the world, having a higher percentage of butter fat than any condensed milk he had ever examined. There was no prize for the quality but the award will be valuable in advertising another of Coos Bay's famous products.

The quality of the condensed milk is not only due to the quality of milk produced by the Coos Bay country dairy herds, but also to the way it is handled. Manager Keating since he took charge of the condensary has put in a lot of new men, among them a foreman, Mr. Stewart, who won honors by his product exhibited at the Paris exposition.

"Sunrise" at the Oregon State Fair was in competition with "Carnation," "Holly," "Pioneer," in fact all of the best-known brands of condensed milk produced on the Pacific coast and in the east.
