

# WATER WORKS DEAL IS OFF

Negotiations by P. A. Devers and Robt. E. Strahorn of Spokane, Declared Off.

The negotiations which have been quietly conducted for sometime by P. A. Devers, on behalf of himself and Robert E. Strahorn of Spokane, Washington, for the purchase of the Coos Bay Water Works, on which Mr. Devers held an option, have been broken off without result. This is the water system that serves Marshfield and North Bend.

Otto A. Welle, who was recently called by the Marshfield City Council in consultation on plans for the proposed sewage system, made an exhaustive examination of the Water Works system in the interest of Messrs. Devers and Strahorn during the month of July. He found that the quality and quantity of water controlled by the Water Company in Pony Creek, immediately west of the city, afforded ample nucleus for a water system sufficient to meet the needs of 20,000 to 30,000 people. The negotiations have been finally declared off.
