MYRTLE POINT POINTERS.

News of Interest of Upper Coquille Taken From The Enterprise.

The regular annual meeting of the Coquille Valley Fruit Growers association will be held in Myrtle Point the first Wednesday in January, which this year falls on the 6th. At that time a new board of directors and new set of officers are to be chosen. The united interest of members of the association in this meeting will contribute immensely toward making the association the success that it should be. The organization is new and not a great deal of apparent good has been accomplished, except to instill a new interest in the fruit possibilities of this portion of the state.

Orion Johnson, Jr., who was arrested on complaint of Ora Marsters on the charge of killing a dog belonging to the latter, and was bound over to the circuit court, was not brought to trial, the case having been thrown out of court.

R. E. Shine, manager of the Southern Oregon Company of Empire, was in Myrtle Point Wednesday to look after the remodeling of the building belonging to that company at the corner of Spruce and Fifth streets for postoffice purposes. The plans contemplate a new front with a corner entrance, a skylight over the private apartments of the office. A side entrance is to be opened toward the back of the building for receiving the mails and other changes are to be made to adapt it to postoffice requirements.

Sam Samuels, who with his wife, had been in Myrtle Point for several months, died in a hospital at San Francisco November 28th. His mind was shattered as a result of his experiences in the earthquake.

The good roads movement is evidently taking hold in Douglas county as appears from the county court records. It is shown that of the 55 almost half of them, have presented resolutions to the court preparatory to voting a special tax for road purposes. In 1907, only four districts presented such resolutions, and 1906 there were but five that took the necessary steps for road improvement. The evidence is that the era of bad roads in Douglas county is drawing to a close. Coos county, it is believed, will meet her neighbor better than half way in road improvement.

They will have speeches in regard to the advertising of Coquille and the Coquille Valley, as to inducing new industries to come to Coquille and in regard to the increased growth of the farming community around the city. Messrs. Morrison, Peoples, Land, Baxter and Lyons were appointed as a committee to make arrangements.

CROWDS WAREHOUSE.

Furniture for New Hotel Is Ready to Put in Place.

The furniture for the new Chandler hotel, or at least a good part of it, is occupying about half the space in the Dow warehouse. It arrived on a recent boat and there is still more to come.

E. D. LaChance, the manager of the hotel, announced that Harry J. McKeown, his partner who will be associated with him in conducting the place, will arrive here shortly. The upper floors of the hotel are nearly done and the work yet to be finished is on the first floor of the building. It is hoped to have everything in readiness to open the hotel by January 15 at least. The furniture and fixtures which have been purchased and which are now arriving are of the very best, and the hotel will be excelled by none in the state in the way of equipment. Jake Goldie, who has offered his resignation at the Millcome Club, is to have charge of the cafe and will have ready his department for the general opening.
