20,640,000 HORSES.

WASHINGTON, Feb. 13.—Horses in the United States numbered 20,640,000 and were valued at \$1,974,052,000, an average of \$95.61 per head on January 1 last, according to a report issued by the department of agriculture.

Ohio Young Woman Sends Message In Package to Chandler Hotel.

PRaises Dredge Oregon.

Capt. Magenn Tells Portland Newspapers of Its Work.

The Portland Telegram says: "Three hundred feet wide and 20 feet deep at the low water mark will be the width and depth of the new channel being dug at Coos Bay by the dredge Oregon before she completes operations. It will permit of the deepest draft vessels reaching Marshfield and North Bend without any difficulty by following the tides. Ships of ordinary draft will be able to get in and out of there at any hour of the day. Captain Macgenna, master of the steamer Breakwater, arriving from Coos Bay says the dredge Oregon is doing splendid work. He also states there is not another dredge on the Pacific Coast which has made a more creditable showing in the short period of her service. Already the skipper explains that she has the channel down to the 20-foot stage and of a uniform width of 150 feet. On reaching the full length of the harbor she will retrace her course and give the channel an additional width of 300 feet. The material thus removed is being used for filling in the lowlands, and as a consequence the value of the property is being greatly enhanced. The Breakwater brought 300 tons of coal and miscellaneous freight and the usual number of passengers.

SAYS ALL CHILDREN ARE BORN LIARS.

Address By a Wisconsin University Professor Shocks a Chicago Woman's Club.

CHICAGO, Feb. 13.—"All children are born liars," Prof. E. V. O'Dea of Wisconsin university said in an address before the Evanston Women's club.
