TEXT OF MARSHFIELD STREET CAR FRANCHISE

(Continued from page 3.)

failure, neglect or refusal thereof shall work as a forfeiture of all the rights and franchise granted by this ordinance.

Section 12. In case the said —, its successors or assigns, shall by its failure, neglect or refusal to perform the conditions on its part herein contained, and hereby forfeit the rights and privileges granted by this ordinance, the city council may proceed and annul this ordinance and repeal the same and thereby determine, rescind and nullify any and all agreements, rights and privileges herein granted to the —, its successors and assigns, under this ordinance, by causing the Recorder of the City of Marshfield to issue notice directed to the said —, its successors or assigns, notifying them of their failure, refusal or neglect to perform any of the conditions on its part contained in this ordinance, and the said notice shall be served upon the officer, agent or employee in charge of the —, its successors and assigns, in Coos county, Oregon.

The City Marshal upon serving said notice upon said —, its successors or assigns, shall return to the Recorder to be filed with the records of his office a duplicate notice with a return of service, by him thereunto attached, giving all the facts in connection with the manner and form by which the notice was served upon said —, its successors or assigns.

At the first meeting after the expiration of thirty days from the date of the service of said notice the city council may proceed and declare by ordinance the repeal, annulment and forfeiture of this ordinance and any and all rights herein granted; provided, however, that if the said —, its successors or assigns, shall have remedied said defect or made suitable and satisfactory compensation or arrangements with the city council therefor, said matter may be passed, provided, however, that no change in the terms or conditions of this ordinance can be made by the City council without an ordinance being duly passed as by law required before making the arrangement aforesaid, such arrangement shall be only of a temporary effect and purpose.

Nothing, however, contained in this section or the subsequent action of the city council of the City of Marshfield, unless by amendment or repeal of this ordinance, shall be deemed as waiving any of the requirements or duties of the said —, its successors and assigns, to perform each or any and all of the terms and conditions on its part herein contained; and in the event of failure of the council to act at the first meeting after the expiration of thirty days from the date of the service of the notice above mentioned, such failure shall in no wise prevent the council from taking subsequent action upon such failure, neglect or refusal of the said —, its successors or assigns.

signs, to comply with the terms of this ordinance.

Section 13. In constructing said street railway upon any of the streets hereinabove mentioned where said street is constructed by bridge or trestle-work and said bridge or trestle-work shall not be built or constructed the full width of said street, then in that event said —, its successors or assigns, shall be permitted to lay or construct its track upon either side of said bridge or trestle-work not closer than ten feet within the property line thereof, or it may, if it so desires, construct said track in the center of said bridge or trestle, but before so doing it shall build and construct in a good substantial and workmanlike manner on each side of and permanently connected with said bridge or trestle a bridge or trestle equal in width to the amount of space to be occupied by said railway and one foot on each side thereof; provided further, however, that in case the said street shall be filled and graded with dirt, rock or other solid matter, and said bridge or trestle work done away with by the city in opening or improvement thereof, then in that event the said —, its successors or assigns, shall relay said track or tracks so that the same shall be as near the center of said street as possible.

Section 14. It shall be unlawful for any person or persons to obstruct the laying down, construction, maintenance or operation of the railways, poles, wires, underground conduits, cables, or conductors mentioned in this ordinance, and any person or persons who shall violate the provisions of this section shall be deemed guilty of a violation of this ordinance, and upon conviction thereof before the municipal court of the City of Marshfield shall be punished by a fine of not less than five dollars nor more than One Hundred Dollars for each and every offense.

Section 15. Any conductor, motorman, or other employee of or upon the railways of said —, its successors or assigns, or any passenger thereon or other person on or about the same, or the cars belonging thereto, or being operated thereon, who shall by indecent, opprobrious, profane, offensive, abusive, or obscene language, or otherwise insult, abuse, or maltreat any passenger on said cars, or any conductor, motorman, or gripman or employee of said —, its successors or assigns, thereon or about the same, shall be deemed guilty of a violation of this ordinance, and upon conviction thereof before the municipal court of the City of Marshfield shall be punished by a fine of not less than Five Dollars nor more than One Hundred Dollars for each and every offense.

Section 16. At all times the power and right to reasonably regulate in the public interests the exercise of the franchise and right granted by this ordinance shall remain and be vested in the council, and said power and right shall not be by it divested or granted.

Section 17. The —, its successors or assigns, hereafter upon the sale, transfer, mortgage or lease being made of the lines of street railway, or of the franchise, rights and privileges hereby granted, shall within five days thereafter, file with the recorder or auditor of the City of Marshfield a copy of the deed, agreement, mortgage, lease or other written instrument evidencing such sale, transfer, or lease certified and sworn to as correct by the grantee in person, if an individual, or by the president or secretary, if a corporation; and every sale, transfer, mortgage or lease of such franchise, whether voluntarily or involuntarily, shall be deemed void and of no effect unless the grantee shall within five days after the same shall have been made, file such certified copy as required by this section. The Recorder or Auditor shall file all such documents, and shall make and keep an index of the same in a book to be kept by him for that purpose, which book shall be a part of the public records of the city.

Section 18. The said —, shall within thirty days after the approval of this ordinance file in the office of the Recorder or Auditor of the City of Marshfield, its written acceptance of this ordinance and the franchise by this ordinance granted to and conferred upon it, its successors or assigns, subject to the terms, restrictions and provisions in this ordinance contained. Failure of said — to accept this ordinance within thirty days from the final approval thereof, shall be deemed and held to be a rejection by said — of this ordinance, and upon

the expiration of the time allowed for the acceptance of this ordinance, the same not having been accepted, this ordinance shall become and be wholly void, inoperative and of no effect.

Section 19. At any time that the City of Marshfield, its successor or its successor in name, including any and all territory embraced therein, shall contain a population of 25,000 people, then in addition to the terms and agreements to be performed by the said —, its successors or assigns, under this franchise, it shall pay to the said City of Marshfield, or its successor, the sum of one per cent per annum upon the gross earnings of said —, its successors or assigns, in the operation of said railways under and by virtue of this ordinance.

And the said —, its successors or assigns, shall upon demand make a report to the City of Marshfield, or its successor, or such officer as may by ordinance be designated, showing the gross amount of earnings of said —, its successors or assigns, after the said City of Marshfield shall contain a population of 25,000 people, said report shall be verified by oath of the principal officer or agent of said company having charge of the management of its business within Coos county, State of Oregon, and in case the city council shall determine that said report is not satisfactory, then in that event the city shall have the right to inspect the books of said company, its successors or assigns.

Section 20. The said —, its successors or assigns, is hereby limited to a charge of not more than five cents (5c) per person for fare in any one general direction upon its cars within the corporate limits of the City of Marshfield, or its successor, or any extensions hereinafter made or created as to the boundaries of said city or its successor. And it is hereby stipulated and agreed that any and all police officers and firemen on duty shall be entitled to free fare upon said cars.

Section 21. If the said —, its successors or assigns, shall not begin the construction of the said railway within sixty (60) days from the date of the passage of the ordinance and vigorously and continuously prosecute the construction of same and shall not complete the same upon all the streets above enumerated and have its cars in operation thereon in accordance with this ordinance, within said fourteen (14) months from the date of this ordinance, then in that event this ordinance shall cease and determine and be of no further effect and wholly void as to the granting of any privileges, easements or right-of-ways for the use of the streets above enumerated or any portion thereof; but in the event that the said —, its successors or assigns, shall have completed the laying of said tracks upon the said streets above enumerated, and has its cars in operation thereon in conformity with the regulations contained in this ordinance, then and in that event this ordinance and the rights, privileges and franchises herein contained shall continue and be in full force and effect for the period of thirty years from the date of the passage of this ordinance, subject, however, to be created, terminated and annulled for the causes and in the manner in the ordinance hereinbefore stated.

Section 22. This ordinance and privilege also allows the said —, its successors or assigns, to arrange for the transportation of funerals and persons attending the same over and upon its said railways.

Section 23. The said —, its successors or assigns, is hereby required in case they disturb the cross-walks or any portion of the graded or improved surface of any street to immediately replace the same in as good condition as such improvement was prior to its being disturbed, and in the erection of any and all poles, wires or other apparatus for the transmission of power, the same shall be done in accordance with the reasonable rules and regulations enacted by ordinance by the council of the City of Marshfield, or its successor.

Section 24. This contract and the agreements, terms and conditions thereof, shall inure to, apply to and bind the successors and assigns of the —.
