come. The best seats were going rapidly this morning but the big capacity of the rink will undoubtedly accommodate all who wish to attend.

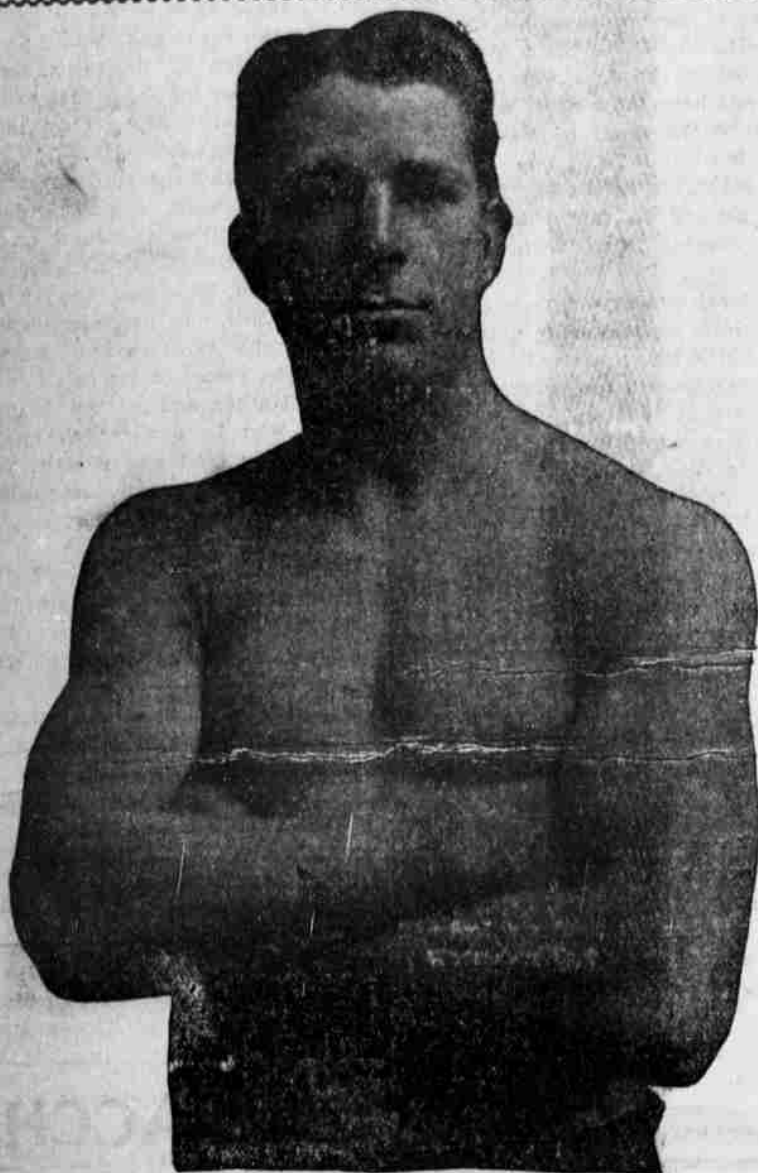
Prior to the principal bout of the evening Willie O'Neill of Australia, and Ed. Parsons will engage in a

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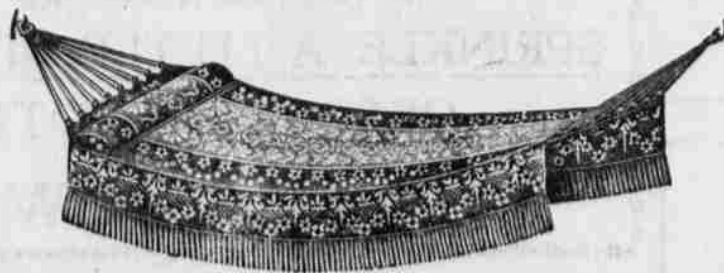
