CONFIDENCE.

THE CHARACTER of the prosperity that the country is gaining little by little is made apparent in the last issue of Dun's Review:

"Reports from the principal industrial and mercantile centers are of an encouraging nature, and even the long delay in tariff readjustment and the new controversy over the proposition to levy a tax on the net earnings of corporation do not seem to hold in check the improvement in business conditions."

A year ago the business world would have been set on edge by a proposal from the White House that corporations be taxed and of an amendment permitting the application of an income tax. Business was feverish then, suffering from a severe shock to the nerves, timid and ready to fly to safety at every sign of waning confidence.

It speaks well for conditions that two measures which will reduce dividends and will, besides, place corporations under the eye and regulations of the government have caused such little disturbance. There is walling and howling in the vicinity of Wall street. The regulations and the tax the street is not greatly troubled over. It recognizes that the restraint is only indirect and it believes the tax can be made up by the increased earnings forecast in the next era of prosperity. But it dreads the oversight and the evidence gathered by federal study of corporation books. Beyond this local uneasiness little agitation is apparent. We are on the margin of solid prosperity.

Commencing with August 1, 1909, the following schedule of rates for rental of telephones in the city of Marshfield, Ore., will go into effect:

One party residence phones, \$2.50; if paid at office on or before the 15th of each month, \$2.35.

Two party residence phones, \$2.00; if paid at office on or before the 15th of each month, \$1.90.

Four party residence phones, \$1.75; if paid at office on or before the 15th of each month, \$1.65.

One party business phones, \$3.00; if paid at office on or before the 15th of each month, \$2.85.

Two party business phones, \$2.50; if paid at office on or before the 15th of each month, \$2.35.

Four party business phones, \$2.25; if paid at office on or before the 15th of each month, \$2.10.

If these rentals are not paid on or before the 15th of each month no reduction will be made, and no collector will call for the amount due on bills, but if paid by that time said discount will be allowed. Any patron wishing to be changed from the present service to a one, two or four party line, will please notify the company at once, or phone No. 121, so that the change can be made and the new number corrected in the directory.
