A FATAL DEFECT.

ANY NOVICE in transportation could have pointed out to A. Brodbeck of Salt Lake City a fatal initial defect in his plan to establish an airship line from New York to London, via Peking.

This proposition has been submitted by the westerner to the postoffice department and the second assistant postmaster general has passed upon it, calling the inventor's attention to the fact that it would be impossible for the government to subsidize the line for carrying mails for the reason that the law has been so drawn as to appropriate funds for transportation of mails by railroad only.

But this is not the fatal defect, for we have no doubt that the Hon. Stephen B. Elkins of the commerce committee would promptly co-operate with the Hon. Boise Penrose of the post roads committee in amending the law so as to let airships in on the good things which congress provides.

In unfolding his plan to the postoffice department, Mr. Brodbeck pointed out the advantages incident to his proposed line which would avoid both oceans since he would deflect its course at San Francisco to Bering, via Alaska. "The principal stations," he explained, "would be New York, Chicago, Omaha, Denver, Salt Lake City, San Francisco, Seattle, Fort Williams, Bering, Sakhalin, Tokio, Peking, Irkutsk, Omsk, Orenburg, Moscow, St. Petersburg, Riga, Berlin, Cologne, Paris and London."

This list of towns is all right as far as it goes. The fatal defect lies in an omission. It is impossible to figure out how the aviator scheme of the Salt Lake man can succeed that leaves off its line such an important place as Coos Bay and the attention of Railway Booster J. W. Bennett is directed thereto.




