PROFESSOR ZUEBLIN character-
izes thrift as a vice, and he
seriously advises all his audi-
tors to spend freely in order that the
standard of living may be raised.

As if in this era of high living in
America there were necessity to raise

To treat thrift as a vice is to reverse
all previous ethics, also all notions
of political economy, and likewise
every common-sense conclusion of
practical life. But Zueblin usually
prefers to be preposterous, and in this

is questioned, mere impertinence is
often considered originality.

unethical, and Zueblin being both,

Ferrero, the historian, has shown

come to withdraw more than is sup-
plied.

Zueblin may vaporize as much as
he pleases; but Zueblin is no match
for mathematics. Arithmetic is in-
vincible, and never has successfully
been controverted. Thrift remains
the cardinal economic virtue. What
is capital but the savings of society?
Thrift has lifted men from savagery.
The savage spends all he has, and the
beginning of civilization was when
the savage commenced to save.

Nowadays the "tight-wad" is ta-
boo, and the unloveliness of the saving
man is celebrated in novel and play.
But is the spender so beautiful to
look upon? Are his virtues conspicu-
ous, or is not his degeneration appar-
ent? By which way does the individ-
ual develop—by curbing his appet-
ites or indulging them, by self-denial
or self-coddling?
