## FINAL TRY TO SECURE NAMES

Plan to Have Thorough Canvass of City Made for Census Enumeration.

Local men are today discussing means of making a final roundup of the city to insure that the census enumeration here is made as complete as possible. The enumerators, Mrs. Dungan and Mrs. Hewitt, are expected to have their work done by May 15 so that only a few days remain in which to make the roundup.

Wm. Grimes today suggested that as many citizens as possible be enlisted in such a plan. He suggests that one person in each block in the city make a canvass of his or her block, getting the names of every resident in it and then turn these lists in and be checked over by the enumerators. Whether this plan will be adopted is not certain yet.

Unless some such means is employed, it is feared that a large number here who are employed in the logging camps and on work outside of town will not be included although their actual home is in Marshfield.

Besides this, every person is urged to turn in the names of any one who they know has not been enumerated to the Chamber of Commerce or the enumerators.
