PROVISION FOR PARKS.

COOS BAY CITIES in general and Marshfield in particular, must not neglect making provision for parks while the land may be obtained at reasonable prices.

At present there are a number of tracts of land in Marshfield which have splendid possibilities for scenic beauty, that can be acquired by the city now very reasonable, but later the experience of the B street dock property which the city acquired may be repeated and several times present prices have to be paid.

We do not now realize what the need for parks and playgrounds in this city ten or twenty years hence. It is deplorably short sighted for a city that has such opportunities as Marshfield now possesses to sacrifice these opportunities for purely selfish reasons.

The argument of cost has no merit whatever. The parks can never be a burden to the city, and the increase in real estate values will make them at all times a good investment.

Unfortunately the people of Marshfield have not taken this park situation seriously enough. We are all too much engrossed in our personal and private affairs. But in a few years, if half our dreams come true, we will be humiliated if we find that this rich and resourceful section of the country so gave itself over to things of sordid and selfish concern as to forget altogether the comfort and health and pleasure of its people.
