COOS BAY BEAUTIFUL.

SOMETIMES we are almost convinced that the commercialism that would level the hills of this peninsula would practically destroy the real and bountiful beauty of the site of Coos Bay, abate the charm that distinguishes it now and make it ordinary, common and flat, altogether too much like the majority of cities. There is something unique and alluring in such a site as ours; an attractiveness, a distinction that few places possess, the lowering of which to the commercial levels demanded would utterly destroy. Some of the land and water scapes would suffer obliteration and these are an asset of no mean value. There are those now who would fill Mill Inlet to make the south section of the city a solid, unbroken flat. The proper policy for filling in the low places is with the dredge from the bay rather than from the magnificent hills, save what of them shall be reduced to conform to the essential grades.

San Francisco has in the main retained the sharp and lofty configuration of the peninsula she adorns, and we should do the same. There is nothing to compare in point of impressive and satisfying persuasion upon the mind of the visitor approaching Coos Bay for the first time, with the lofty and splendid prominence of this semi-mountainous peninsula, dotted, but not yet crowned with hundreds of homes and structures that grace it to-day, and which must in course of time increase in beauty and significance on all sides. Whatever develops in the way of civic improvement here should be confined, sharply and continuously, to the scheme of maintaining the

glory of the heights and preservation of the magnificent views now ours. They are incomparable in their way, and their magnitude and variety are but rarely matched, and but approximately duplicated throughout the world. It were consummate folly to annihilate them or even discount the generous gratuity nature has bestowed upon us. Coos Bay will do well, indeed, to see that the engineers of the future shall do all they may to leave undisturbed these fine attributes, that year by year, are becoming more and more valuable in the scheme of things on Coos Bay.
